NC OPIOID SETTLEMENT

PROJECT ORDINANCE

ASHE COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Ashe County, North Carolina that pursuant to Section 13.2 of Chapter 159 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, the following project ordinance is hereby adopted:

Section 1. The project authorized consists of disbursing eligible expenditures and reimbursements of the NC Opioid Settlement monies distributed to Ashe County under the NC Opioid Settlement and the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the NC Department of Justice and Ashe County

Section 2. The officers of this unit are hereby directed to proceed with the project within the terms of the documents and the budget contained herein.

Section 3. The following available revenues are appropriated for the project:

Opioid Settlement Funds \$1,131,483

TOTAL REVENUES \$1,131,483

Section 4. The following amounts are available for expenditures for the project:

Operational Expenses and Grants to Other Agencies \$1,131,483

TOTAL EXPENDITURES \$1,131,483

Section 5. The Finance Officer is hereby directed to maintain within the Project Fund sufficient specific detailed accounting records to satisfy the requirements of the grantor agencies, any grant agreements, and federal regulations.

| Section 6. Funds may be advanced from the General Fund or the Opioid Settlement Fund for |
