PROJECT ORDINANCE

ASHE COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Ashe County, North Carolina that pursuant to Section 13.2 of Chapter 159 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, the following project ordinance is hereby adopted:

Section 1. The project authorized consists of disbursing eligible expenditures and reimbursements of reimbursable Golden LEAF Grant funds and BREMCO REDLG funds distributed to Ashe County for the project.

Section 2. The officers of this unit are hereby directed to proceed with the project within the terms of the documents and the budget contained herein.

Section 3. The following available revenues are appropriated for the project:

Golden LEAF Funds \$ 1,425,000

Economic Development Reserve Fund Appropriation \$ 70,000

BREMCO REDLG Funds \$ 1,360,000

TOTAL REVENUES \$ 2,855,000

Section 4. The following amounts are available for expenditures for the project:

Operational Expenses and Grants to Other Agencies \$ 2,855,000

TOTAL EXPENDITURES \$ 2,855,000

Section 5. The Finance Officer is hereby directed to maintain within the Project Fund sufficient specific detailed accounting records to satisfy the requirements of the grantor agencies, any grant agreements, and federal regulations.

Section 6. Funds may be advanced from the General Fund or the Economic Development
Reserve Fund for the purpose of making payments that shall be reimbursed from the Project
Fund. Any unexpended funds appropriated or funds for ineligible expenditures shall be
reimbursed to the granting agencies as provided by applicable law or regulation.

Section 7. Within five days after adoption, copies of this Project Ordinance shall be made available to the Budget Officer and the Finance Officer for direction in carrying out this project. A copy of this ordinance shall be filed in the office of the Clerk to the Board
