Exhibit A: Contract Conditions

1.0 General Conditions

- 1.1 The work will include mowing and yard maintenance services as outlined in the Scope of Work.
- 1.2 The Contractor shall furnish all supervision, labor, and equipment required to perform the services outlined.
- 1.3 The Contractor will be required to submit names and social security numbers of all persons who will work at the facilities. These persons must sign a written consent form for a background check prior to beginning work. The contractor must assure that they are an Equal Opportunity Employer.
- 1.4 All Contractors must furnish to the County, a list of references which includes at least one past and/or present business client.
- 1.5 All contractors shall read the entire bid document thoroughly to gain a clear understanding of all requirements under this request. When making a bid, contractors should include all costs related to this project.
- 1.6 The Contractor shall be responsible for the protection from his/her activities of all public and private property on and adjacent to the work area and shall use suitable precautions to prevent damage to property, fences, pipes, conduits, and other underground structures, and to poles, wires, cables and overhead structures. It shall be the responsibility of the Contractor to promptly restore, replace or make good any damage or injury to all public and private property. If the Contractor fails to do so, the County may, at the Contractors expense, repair, rebuild, or otherwise restore such property. Any expense incurred by the County to repair damages will be withheld from the contractor's monthly payment.

2.0 Scope of Work

Services shall be performed as follows:

Mowing, weed eating, and blowing grass/debris from sidewalks at the following locations. Frequency of mowing is indicated by each location.

Grass at the County Park shall be mowed during the early hours of the morning to avoid peak hours. The contractor shall make schedule arrangements with the Parks and Recreation Director. This facility contains a lot of weed eating and may take additional hours to complete.

County Maintenance personnel will give direction on what needs to be mowed, trimmed, or sprayed with weed killer as appropriate at all sites. Mowing shall not occur when the ground is saturated and could cause damage to the turf.

Each project area may be awarded a separate contract based on the lowest responsible bid for that project or one award may be issued for all projects. One contract may be issued for all project areas, if a contractor submits a successful bid for each project area.

3.0 Insurance

Contractor must provide proof of applicable worker's compensation insurance as required by the State of North Carolina and proof of automatic liability insurance with \$500,000 combined single limits for bodily injury and property damage. Insurance must be maintained throughout the term of the contract.

4.0 Terms of Contract

- 4.1 This agreement shall be for a year and a half beginning July 1, 2025 and continue until June 30, 2026. If mutually agreeable, this contract may be extended annually. In the event that this agreement proves unsatisfactory, it may be terminated by a 30 day written notice by either party.
- 4.2 Failure of the contractor to meet or perform work to these specifications as determined by the County shall warrant written notice to the contractor specifying areas of nonperformance or unacceptable performance and the contractor shall have ten (10) days to rectify. Immediate cancellation of the contract may occur if performance is not rectified in ten (10) days.
- 4.3 Payment will be processed in a timely manner and shall only be made after a written invoice is received that indicates the areas mowed for the month billed. Invoices should be received two weeks prior to the end of the month so that payment can be processed in a timely manner. Contractor will be paid at the end of each month based on satisfactory completion of work.

5.0 Addendums

Any change to this Request for Proposals will be issued in writing and shall become a part of the bid.
