

AGRICULTURE CENTER CONSTRUCTION  
AMENDED AND FINAL PROJECT ORDINANCE  
ASHE COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Ashe County, North Carolina that pursuant to Section 13.2 of Chapter 159 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, the following project ordinance is hereby adopted:

Section 1. The project authorized consists of disbursing eligible expenditures and reimbursements of funds for the construction of an Agriculture Center located in the Town of Jefferson, North Carolina.

Section 2. The officers of this unit are hereby directed to proceed with the project within the terms of the documents and the budget contained herein.

Section 3. The following available revenues are appropriated for the project:

Section 4. The following amounts are available for expenditures for the project:

Capital Improvement & Construction Expenditures	<u>\$4,522,840</u>

Section 5. The Finance Officer is hereby directed to maintain within the Project Fund sufficient specific detailed accounting records to satisfy the requirements of the grantor agencies, any grant agreements, and federal regulations.

Section 6. Funds may be advanced from the General Fund or the County - Capital Improvements & Construction Fund for the purpose of making any of the payments that shall be reimbursed from Grants listed in the available revenues for this project along with local County expenditure appropriations. Any unexpended grant funds appropriated or funds for ineligible expenditures shall be reimbursed to the granting agencies as provided by applicable law or regulation.

Section 7. Within five days after adoption, copies of this Project Ordinance shall be made available to the Budget Officer and the Finance Officer for direction in carrying out this project. A copy of this ordinance shall be filed in the office of the Clerk to the Board
