


Energy Assistance Crisis Intervention Program



CIP is an energy program designed to provide assistance to households in crisis (i.e. out of fuel or almost out of fuel).

Qualifying households receive a voucher for a one-time fuel delivery.


Applications may be completed:

- ◆ By phone
 - ◆ By drop-off application
 - ◆ In-person at Ashe County DSS
 - ◆ Online at <https://epass.nc.gov>.

To qualify for assistance, households MUST:

- ◆ Be experiencing a **heating or cooling related crisis**.
- ◆ Meet income eligibility guidelines.

Applicants MUST provide:

- ◆ Information including name, date of birth and social security numbers for all household members.
 - ◆ Verification of all household income.
 - ◆ Electric and heating account numbers.
