### **General Fund:**

To increase the appropriation for the department of <u>Social Services</u> from \$10,905,090 to \$11,060,301; this increased appropriation of \$155,211 to be made with an appropriation of \$27,859 from Essential Services Funding – Rental Assistance, \$72,266 from Essential Services Funding – Child Welfare, and \$55,086 from Essential Services Funding – Adult Assistance. These funds were made available by the State of North Carolina on 12-3-2024 and deposited into the county account as of 12-13-2024.
