

**RESOLUTION
AWARDING BADGE AND SERVICE SIDEARM TO
RETIRING OFFICER JERRY LEWIS**

WHEREAS, Jerry Lewis, served the Ashe County Sheriff's Office from December 16, 2006 through July 30, 2016; and

WHEREAS, Jerry Lewis has dedicated his life to law enforcement and public service in Ashe County; and

WHEREAS, NCGS 20-187.2 provides that retiring members of county law enforcement agencies may receive, at the time of their retirement, the badge worn or carried by them during their service with the County; and

WHEREAS, NCGS 20-187.2 further provides that the governing body of the governing law enforcement agency may, at its discretion, award to a retiring member the service sidearm of such retiring member; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with NCGS 20-187.2 the attached permit number, 16-8679, has been issued on the following weapon: Glock, Model 21, .45 caliber handgun, Serial # PCK840 and this weapon is officially declared as surplus.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Ashe County Board of Commissioners that in accordance with the provisions of NCGS 20-187.2, the badge and above referenced service sidearm of Jerry Lewis be transferred to him in honor of his retirement as an Ashe County Sheriff's Detective.
