BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the aforesaid contracts by and between the County of Ashe, various State contracts and other vendors, and First-Citizens Bank & Trust Company, together with the amounts to be paid thereunder, be and the same are hereby designated as qualified tax-exempt obligations of the County of Ashe for purposes of Section 265(b)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Board of Commissioners does not reasonably expect that the Purchaser (and any subordinate entities) will issue more than \$10,000,000 in qualified tax-exempt obligations pursuant to such Sections 265(b)(3)(ii) during the current calendar year.
