V. Public Comment

Chairman Sands opened the floor for Public Comment.

Donald Nelson spoke to the Board stating concern for what he referred to as a "bottleneck" on a response to his requests for public records. He has placed two Public Records Requests that have not been completed. Mr. Nelson asked the commissioners and the county manager to address the problem. He referenced the importance of the public placing requests for public records. In addition, he explained to the Board guidelines set forth by the Attorney General and the State regarding compliance by local governments in responding to the requests. Mr. Nelson made a plea to receive the information in a timely fashion and stated that he does not believe his requests should take third place behind a high-priced lawyer's request.

No further comment was offered.

VI. Presentations

PRES 17-76 9:05 AM - Zak Ammar, CEO of Vixster, LLC - Application for Solid Waste Franchise

Zak Ammar, CEO of Vixster, LLC, told the Board that his company provides rural trash and recycling collection for citizens in the High Country. He is interested in expanding his business into Ashe County. Commissioner Rhodes asked if there are specific areas in the County that he is interested in. Mr. Ammar answered that he would like to operate the same as he operates in Watauga County which is within any area outside of the city limits. Commissioner Rhodes questioned if a base rate has been established. Mr. Ammar answered that he has not set a base rate because there is a fee at the landfill for residental garbage taken across the scale and he will need to take that fee into consideration when setting the rate. Mr. Ammar uses independent haulers assigned to different areas of the County. The trucks used will be marked as required by the Ashe County Solid Waste Ordinance. Chairman Sands asked what counties Vixster, LLC operates in. Mr. Ammar answered that the business operates in Watauga County and a small part of Avery County. Mr. Ammar questioned why the hauler has to pay a fee when they take garbage to the landfill. Environmental Services Director Scott Hurley explained the process in Ashe County and the option for anyone that pays a company to haul their trash to receive a refund of the Solid Waste Disposal Fee that is paid by each household annually on their property tax bill. Commissioner Roark questioned if it would be simpler to waive the landfill dumping fee for franchised haulers. Mr. Hurley answered that there would be a problem if the customer is a commercial business. Mr. Ammar explained that in Watauga County he provides a list to the County of all of his customers that are commercial. Commissioner Rhodes stated that the problem is with control. The Board has discussed the issue before and did not come up with a good way to handle the issue. Mr. Ammar told the Board that he could provide a customer list on a quarterly basis and he could operate exclusively residential if it is a concern. There were no further questions. The franchise request is required by law to be heard at two meetings of the Board. Therefore, this will be placed on the August 7, 2017 agenda for consideration by
