Gene Painter and Laura Dye were present to provide an update on the Riverview Community Center gym. Mr. Painter provided information on the renovation project detailing the number of hours that volunteers have spent working on the facility, the cost of materials purchased, materials purchased from a donation given by Lowe's Hardware in West Jefferson, outstanding projects, and future projects planned for Riverview Community Center. Ms. Dye asked for approval to cover the windows as proposed. The Board was in agreement with the window proposal.

PRES Pat Considine & Michael Bell - Glendale Springs Clean Air & Fresh Water 19-126 Group

Pat Considine with Glendale Springs Clean Air and Fresh Water group stated appreciation to the Board for their efforts to stop placement of an asphalt plant in Glendale Springs. The last time the group came before the Board a check was presented to the County to assist with legal fees to petition the North Carolina Supreme Court regarding the Polluting Industries Development Ordinance permit. Today, a check was presented for \$11,240 that has been raised to assist the County with legal expenses.

PRES Planning Director Adam Stumb - 2022-2031 State Transportation
19-127 Improvement Plan (STIP)

Planning Director Adam Stumb provided an update on the 2022-2031 State

Transportation Improvement Plan (STIP). He explained that NCDOT is soliciting new projects for the next plan. The following four projects will be submitted for Ashe County:

1) US221 from Ashe Memorial Hospital to the US221/Hwy 16 split (modernization), 2) US221/Hwy 16 split (intersection improvement), 3) Mt. Jefferson Road - Oakwood Drive to Campus Drive (modernization), and 4) Airport Terminal. Other projects that are in the works and identified in other STIPs include: 1) US221E - NC163 intersection to Ashe Memorial Hospital, 2) Beaver Creek School Road & US221 Business Intersection (McDonalds/Ingles), 3) Hwy 88 - Jefferson to Warrensville (ROW 2022 and Construction 2024), and 4) Apron Expansion at Airport (Construction 2022). Planning Director Adam Stumb explained that today's presentation is for informational purposes and will be added to the July 15, 2019 agenda for approval by the Board.
