We would like to take a moment to recognize two of our dispatchers for their actions and response to saving lives of Ashe County Deputies.

In the past year a very dangerous situation occurred in Ashe County that began as a common welfare check. As Deputies responded, a later call into dispatch revealed a disturbing scene. Dispatcher Jenni Bryant put several calls together, connecting the welfare check to the phone number of a disgruntled caller. As deputies arrived on scene, Ms. Bryant and Dispatcher Janna Suttle were able to request deputies to move from the location, wait for backup and advise.

An unbelievable and heroic response by our Dispatchers Jenni Bryant and Janna Suttle ultimately saved several lives. We would like to recognize these individuals.
