Ashe County High School has a back-up generator with an underground fuel storage capacity of 15,000 gallons. There are private back-up generators available in the community for the other shelter sites. Mountain View and Blue Ridge Elementary schools are designated shelters for individuals with limited special needs. Blue Ridge and Mountain View have a generator transfer switch.
