PRES 16-068 School Board Chair Charlie King - Request for Approval to Proceed with Purchase of Property for a New Middle School & Request for Approval of \$60,000 Funding to Proceed

School Board Chair Charlie King introduced School Board members, Maintenance Supervisor Kenny Richardson, and Architect Larry Greene. He then provided background information regarding research for a location on which to build a new middle school. School Board members have found a piece of property they are interested in after looking at several pieces of property in the County. There have been issues with all of the previous properties that School Board members have looked at. Mr. King explained that availability of sewer and water to a property must also be considered. He told the Board that the commissioners will need to approve funds to have soil tested on the property they are considering to make sure the property is suitable for a school. Chairman Rose then made a motion to appropriate \$60,000 for soil testing on the possible middle school site. County Manager Sam Yearick explained the funding appropriation of \$730,105 that was set aside for debt service for schools during the budget work sessions this year. The funds are to be used for costs associated with the new middle school, paving at schools, and Chromebooks for students. The School Board is requesting to use \$60,000 of the debt service monies. Architect Larry Greene spoke to the Board regarding needs for the middle school and estimated that 23 - 25 acres of usable property will be needed for the middle school. With no further comments or questions from the Board, Chairman Rose called for a vote to the motion on the floor. Commissioner Rhodes seconded the motion. The motion passed with unanimous approval.
