Emergency Management Coordinator Patty Gambill provided an update on the petition from citizens to change from the Lansing fire district to the Pond Mountain fire district. Ms. Gambill told the Board that she met with the board of directors of both fire departments on September 5, 2017. Everyone was in agreement to do what is best for the citizens. The recommendation is to change the citizens not in an existing fire insurance district. These citizens will have their tax valuation increase from .04 to .08. If the change is approved by the Board, a findings report will be completed, a public hearing will be held, and a resolution will need to be adopted by the commissioners to change the fire insurance district. Commissioner Roark stated that the citizens will have a higher tax rate but their homeowners insurance will decrease. Commissioner Rhodes then made a motion to approve the citizens' request to change from the Lansing Fire District to the Pond Mountain Fire District. Commissioner Roark seconded the motion. The motion passed with unanimous approval.
