Department of Social Services (DSS) Director Tracie Downer reviewed the monthly Statistical Report for DSS. She told the Board that DSS is on target with the training schedule for employees. In addition, they are engaging in safety improvements for workers in the office environment and especially for workers that are required to go into client homes. Communications for employees housed at Family Central are currently being reworked. An event to provide information and support for foster parents in Ashe County will be held on August 24th at Bald Mountain Baptist Church.

	Next, Medicaid Transportation Unit Supervisor Kathy Turner provided information on the state-mandated program that she supervises for Medicaid recipients. The program ensures medical, dental, and pharmacy transportation through the Ashe County Transportation Authority (ACTA) or by providing gas vouchers for recipients that use their own vehicles. Ms. Turner told the Board that her department has handled 1,716 active cases so far this year.

	Becky Marsten, incoming president of the Arts Council Board of Directors, explained the interview process that took place to fill the position of the Arts Council Director vacated by the retirement of Jane Lonon. Ms. Marsten explained that a transition committee was formed to begin a search for the person that would fill the position. The Arts Council Board resoundingly approved Jeff Fissel as the new director of the Ashe County Arts Council. Mr. Fissel then spoke to the commissioners providing a brief history of his prior work history and education.

	Ann Rose, executive director of Lost Province for the Cultural Arts, stated the vision of the non-profit organization which is "To revitalize our community by preserving and renovating this historic property (the Lansing High School which operated from 1937-1992) promoting the cultural arts and skills of the Appalachian region and creating sustainable multi-use housing." The challenge they are facing is funding to purchase the property. A request is being made for the County to fund the \$45,000 fee for one year for

A request is being made for the County to fund the \$45,000 fee for one year for the accounting firm they will be working with. Ms. Rose explained the impact they expect the project to have on Ashe County. She also highlighted strategic partnerships with other organizations in the County. Expectations are for the project to take five years

from the time the property is purchased until completion. An offer will be made on the property after an environmental assessment, a market analysis, and a feasibility study are completed. Plans include 15 long term apartment rentals on the upper floor and 20 short term rentals. The bottom floor will be reserved for retail space and the high school will be used for classrooms. Commissioner Rhodes stated concern for utilizing taxpayer funds for this type of enterprise. Finance Officer Sandra Long stated that research needs to be made to see if taxpayer funds can be used for this purpose.

Planning Director Adam Stumb presented four State Transportation Improvement Plan (STIP) projects for submission to the North Carolina Department of Transportation. Based on projects submitted in the past and based on requests by the towns, the following projects will be submitted: 1) US221 from Ashe Memorial Hospital to the US221/Hwy16 split, 2) Hwy163 - Nettle Knob to US221, 3) Mt. Jefferson Road - Oakwood Drive to Campus Drive, and 4) Airport Terminal. Planning Director Stumb explained that a change has been made from the projects proposed at the last meeting of the Board. The Department of Transportation suggested that two projects be combined for submission as one project, US221 from Ashe Memorial Hospital to US221/16 split and US221/16 split intersection improvement. Project NC163 - Nettle Knob to US221 will now be added to the projects submitted. Commissioner Rhodes made a motion to approve the STIP 2022-2031 projects proposal as presented. Commissioner Perry seconded the motion. The motion passed with unanimous approval. **Approved**
