Department of Social Services (DSS) Director Tracie Downer presented the monthly departmental update for DSS including statistics for July 2019. Ms. Downer made a request for the commissioners to approve a budget amendment for \$40,960 received in adoption incentives. The funds will be used to recruit foster parents and adoptive parents. Commissioner Rhodes made a motion to approve the budget amendment as presented. Vice Chairman Sands seconded the motion. The motion passed with unanimous approval.

Next, DSS Director Downer told the Board that recipients of Food and Nutrition Services Funds received their September monthly benefits early due to Hurricane Dorian. Even though the hurricane did not affect this area, the early benefits are provided statewide. The benefits for October will be also be early and November benefits will be back on the normal schedule. She encouraged recipients to budget appropriately.

The Keep Ashe Warm non-profit that assists with heating costs for those qualifying for assistance will hold a fundraiser on September 27, 2019 from 7:00 a.m. - 10:00 a.m. at Shatley Springs Restaurant.

She updated the Board on the foster initiative held recently at Bald Mountain Church telling the Board that the meeting was a success.

BUDGET AMENDMENT September 16, 2019
