Interim County Manager Adam Stumb reviewed a Memorandum of Agreement between Ashe County and Gabe Miller regarding a parcel of property on Old Wilkesboro Road. The County has a lien against the property that stipulates the property will be cleaned up within 24 months of the date of the agreement. That part of the agreement has been kept. The property must then remain cleaned up for two years and all back taxes paid up to date and kept current. This portion of the agreement will begin on November 4, 2019 and end on November 4, 2021.
