Census Bureau Specialist Rick Farmer provided a PowerPoint presentation to update the Board on the 2020 Census. There are seven census offices across North Carolina and Ashe County falls under the Winston Salem office. He explained the importance of having an accurate census which determines the number of seats we have in Congress. Each person counted is equivalent to \$2000 in federal taxes for local communities. Each county will need to set up a Complete Count Committee that will be made up of trusted voices in the community that will work to develop outreach plans. The new census will start in March 2020 although the official beginning date is April 1, 2020. A resolution supporting and partnering with the 2020 Census was presented for approval by the Board. Commissioner Rhodes made a motion to approve the resolution. Commissioner Dix seconded the motion. The motion passed with unanimous approval.
