Chairman McNeill opened the public hearing at 9:04 a.m. that was being held for the purpose of gaining citizen input on the acquisition of real property located off of Ray Taylor Road that will be used for an industrial park. The County will purchase the land from Ashe County Job Development (ACJD) for \$950,000 which includes \$650,000 at closing on August 18, 2020 and \$300,000 at a later date. Funding sources include the County of Ashe and loans from ACJD and SkyLine/Skybest. No comment was offered from the public. The public hearing was closed at 9:05 a.m. Commissioner Dix made a motion for the County of Ashe to purchase real property (PIN 192227-079) located off of Ray Taylor Road for \$950,000 on August 18, 2020. The funding sources include the County of Ashe, a SkyBest/SkyLine loan of \$400,000, and an ACJD loan of \$300,000. Vice Chairman Rhodes seconded the motion. The motion passed with unanimous approval.

Tax Administrator Chris Lambert provided an overview of the Eagleview Pictometry project prior to signing the contract with Eagleview. The pictometry will provide a 45-degree view of all properties in the County along with an updated street view of all properties. The public will be able to view the information on the County's website and continuous updates to information on the website will be a valuable tool for revaluation of properties. The information will also be available for use by 911 and emergency services, and for law enforcement and fire departments. Photography of properties in Ashe County will take place between December 2020 and February 2021.

County Manager Adam Stumb stated that at the end of this year's budget work sessions, the Board requested that all capital expenses be delayed until October 2020 unless approved by the Board or the county manager. The following capital purchases have been on hold, but due to increased early property tax payments, close to \$1 million more than this time last year, the following projects will be started: 1) Tax Office pictometry software at \$68,409.67; 2) IT/DSS Office 365 software purchase at a 60/40 split of \$24,000 and \$10,400; and 3) Sheriff's Office Viper Radio lease/purchase. No action is required from the Board because the items were approved in this year's budget.

Department of Social Services Director Tracie Downer provided contract information for Traverse software as requested at the last meeting of the Board of Commissioners. Purchase of the software will be paid for this year through COVID-19 funds. She explained that the software will be used for both adult services and child services. Attorney Grier Hurley reviewed the contract prior to being presented to the Board. There is a termination provision included in the contract if the County decides to not continue with the software after the first year. The contract cost is \$77,000 per year for three years. Vice Chairman Rhodes made a motion to approve the purchase of Traverse software for the Department of Social Services Commissioner Sands seconded the motion. The motion passed with unanimous approval. **Approved**
